This is a poor quality radio recording that has been "out there" for a while but is now formally released on a label of sorts. The track list is mis-ordered and incomplete, but the music is worth having no matter what. There are some nice variations in licks and it's always good to hear Chet's concert conversations. Paul Yandell had been with him about a year. *Autumn Leaves*, *When You Wish Upon a Star*, *El Condor Pasa*,

Variations on a theme by Mozart, *Windy and Warm*, *Frog Kissin'*, *Medley (Gallop on Guitar, Mr Sandman, Freight Train)*, *Yakety Axe*, and *Charade*. Also includes a "Tonight Show" unlisted track from around 1981, *Ready for the Times to Get Better*. www.amazon.com
