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This is an alternating-bass "Travis Picking" arrangement of "My Grandfather's Clock." Two other versions are also available at our website, www.AccentOnMusic.com. This arrangement starts out with "pinches" only; all of the melody notes are *on the beat*, picked simultaneously with a bass note. Syncopated melody notes begin at M.9. Be mindful of anticipations: the last note of M. 11 belongs to the F chord of M. 12. In this arrangement, I fret the sixth string in the F chords with my thumb, although a barre will work. If you barre the F in M. 19, sustain the bass note as you raise the base of your index finger to pick the open second string. The D7 chord in M. 22 is a "C7" fingering moved up the neck two frets. Have fun with this! -Mark Hanson
